<b>Purpose of Role:</b>	Safely provide field technical services to support the geology, project development and administration teams and maintain project Best Management Practices (BMP's) in accordance with the Project's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan.

**Overview:** This position is centred around the Black Butte Copper Project, located 17 miles north of White Sulphur Springs, MT. Operations and development of the Project are owned by Sandfire Resources America, Inc. and are carried out by its wholly owned U.S. subsidiary, Tintina Montana, Inc.

The Black Butte Copper Project will be a showcase underground copper mine utilizing state-of-the-art technology and best practise management principles to delivery positive returns for shareholders and set a new benchmark in outcomes for all stakeholders.

This position is responsible for supporting the leadership team of TMI to deliver a showcase underground mine development at Black Butte and work with the operations and geological teams to grow and enhance the geological resources for the Black Butte Copper Project.

- Maintain and organize the BBC core sheds and yard.
  - Maintain the upkeep of the BBC project development site.
  - Install BMP's on the future core drill sites.
  - Maintain the BMPs on current and past core drill sites.
  - Perform reclamation of the roads and core drill pads.
  - Assist with quarterly audits and maintenance of weather station.
  - Oversee and assist onsite contractors and vendors as required.
  - Organize and transport the drill core.

- Cut core samples.
- Implement the Project's weed control program.
- Assist in the care and maintenance of all the Company's buildings, equipment and facilities.
- Assist the geological staff in the transportation, data collection, and sampling of drill core.
- Transport and deliver Company equipment and materials as directed.
- Perform labor necessary to the progress of drilling and sampling programs.
- Perform site and office maintenance.
- Perform other duties as directed by the Supervisor.

- Perform onsite repair, maintenance and tasks.
- Operate vehicles and equipment in a safe manner.
